FOOTBALL MANAGERS

If parents or players experience any problems with their team coach, manager or any Club member or official, they should contact their Football Manager in the first instance. Dependant on the issue, it may be referred to our Member Protection Officer.

If you need to contact any of these officials, please be considerate of the time that you call.

Facilities

The Club's home ground is situated at EDSACC North, Central Coast Hwy, Bateau Bay (opp. Bay Village Shopping Centre). We have excellent training facilities and a playing arena that is the envy of many other clubs on the Coast.

Our complex can accommodate three full size fields, two junior fields and four SSG fields. The complex is fully illuminated by twenty-one floodlights.

The Club building includes the usual amenities (canteen, toilets and change rooms) and has a fully functional clubroom that is used for club activities.

We believe we offer many opportunities for our Junior players to grow in both skill and social development. Our juniors continue to represent our Club in a positive light, displaying great sportsmanship at all times!

Over 35's

The Kripples are Killarney Districts Over 35s teams. Our aims are to enjoy a game of football and to socialise. Last season we registered 4 Over 35s teams (one each in B grade & C grade, plus 2 in D grade) and are expecting similar this season, so, all levels of skill are catered for.

In addition, Shelly Beach Fossils are affiliated with KDSC and have two Over 35s and an Over 45 team.

Games are played Saturday afternoons, 40 minutes each way with unlimited interchange – same as the juniors, you can come off & go back onto the field as many times as you need to, so all levels of fitness are catered for.

Normally we will have a social drink after the weekend matches and will often fire up the BBQ as well. We have a training session (nothing too intense, attendance is encouraged, but is not mandatory) once weekly on Wednesday evenings, with a wind-down drink afterwards.

Registration is \$240 for the 2011 season, and can be done either at the KDSC registration days, or at Wednesday night pre-season training. New players must supply proof of age (copy of drivers licence or similar) and a passport-sized photo (photos can be taken free of charge, at KDSC on registration days, or on Wednesday nights). Our playing strip is KDSC shirt, Nike shorts (available from either KDSC on registration days), and Kripples socks (different to KDSC socks, and available from our Treasurer). We have an end of season presentation night which is free for registered players, plus a Kripples' polo shirt, jacket or similar.

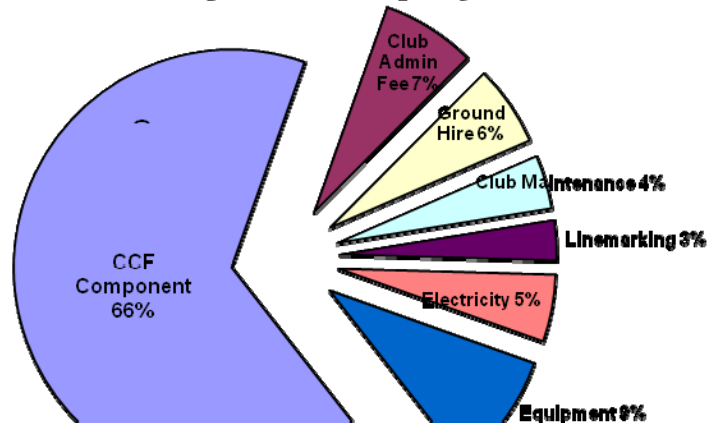

MATCH FEES

A weekly fee is set by the club and **MUST BE PAID TO THE MANAGER OF YOUR CHILD'S TEAM BEFORE YOUR CHILD TAKES PART IN THE GAME.** Please pay your match fees in gold coin and fifty cent pieces only. The match fees cover referee's fees, with remaining funds being used for the annual Presentation Day costs and development of Club facilities. Please pay your child's team manager the appropriate match fee **BEFORE THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE GAME.**

In cases where a player has not paid fees for two weeks or more and requests to that player or parents have proved fruitless, then the Secretary or Treasurer must be notified in writing immediately resulting in possible suspension of the player concerned until fees are paid.

Match fees remain static for 2011 and are as follows;

U5 – U7	\$5.00	Per player per game
U8 – U9	\$6.00	Per player per game
U10 – U16	\$7.00	Per player per game
Seniors	\$8.00	Per player per game

REFUNDS

Once registration monies have been received and;

a) A player withdraws for any reason that the committee determines to be fair and reasonable, prior to team nominations (7th March 2011), then the following deductions will be made before any monies are returned;

- Cost of item supplied at registration eg: ball, shorts etc
- KDSC Administration Fee of \$20.00

b) Refunds will not be considered after 7th March 2011.

c) Refunds for 'change of mind' or injury sustained outside of the game, will not be considered.

An application for refund form is to be completed and submitted to the Secretary, to be tabled at the next committee meeting for consideration.

Once a decision has been made, the player will be notified of same within 2 days of said meeting. No other discussion will be entered into. Refunds are given at the discretion of the Committee.

GRADING OF PLAYERS

All competition teams must be graded and our Club follows the directive set down by Central Coast Football, which is:

D8.3 Grading of Players

a) Clubs must grade each player in accordance with their ability and must submit a full list of gradings to the Association Registrar as directed by the Board.

*To assist our club with the grading of players, coaches of teams from U/7 to U/16 must submit at least two grading assessments on each player during the season. These confidential assessments enable the Grading Committee to determine each player's progress and, each year, the grading of some players will change, based on these assessments and the performance of other players during any grading days if held. Grading is dependent on the player's ability, growth and maturity compared to other players at the Club in that age group

and this should be kept in mind if you are dissatisfied with the grading of your child (see Parent Agreement Form, condition 3).

Non Competition Teams (U5 – U9) Small Sided Football

This year will see the continuation of Small Sided Games on the Central Coast. This year, the U9s will be incorporated into SSG, as per CCF directives.

EQUAL PLAYING OPPORTUNITIES POLICY

It is the Club's objective to provide all team members with equal playing opportunities as part of the commitment to fair play. We understand that in registering to play for the Club, there is an expectation that players will not be discriminated against on any grounds in terms of the treatment they receive from Club officials, coaches or managers.

However, we do acknowledge that in competition soccer there will be individual occasions during a season when the performance of players on the field or at training, may warrant appropriate management action by the coach in the broader team interest. In all such circumstances, players, and if appropriate, parents, should be consulted if such action results in any removal or reduction of playing opportunities.

For competition grades between Under 10 years and 16 years, there is an unlimited player interchange rule and this mechanism should be used to promote and achieve equal playing opportunity for team members. A similar rule applies to Mini Soccer teams (Under 5 to 9 years). **The interchange rule should be used to allow ALL players to play equal time in each match, in preference to the option of selected players missing either a full, or half game on pre-determined weekends.**

Should any player or parent have cause to be aggrieved by the action of a coach, manager or Club official they should bring the matter to the notice of the relevant Football Manager as soon as possible or to the Management Committee in writing, addressed to the Secretary.

DUTIES OF COACHES AND MANAGERS

All Coaches and Managers MUST complete a KDSC Application Form and be registered with Central Coast Football for insurance purposes.

They must agree to:

1. Be photographed and wear to every game, a CCF Registration Card and lanyard. (Note: Persons without a CCF Registration Card are not permitted to fill in for Coaches and Managers.)
2. Attend all Coaches and Managers meetings, (or send a representative from the team).
3. Adhere to all rules and guidelines in the Coaches & Managers Handbook.
4. Inform their team when they have canteen, match day table or net duties.
5. Pass on any written or verbal information to parents when required.
6. Return all equipment to the Equipment Officer on the appointed date.

Please ensure that any non-comp coaches or managers include their personal whistle with their kit. Although we organize cadet refs for every week, there are occasions where we cannot fill all games or there may be unforeseen dropouts at the last minute. Please be understanding and ensure you can cover these games yourself.

JUNIOR LICENCE COACHING COURSE

This is a basic coaching course which includes the organisation and role of the coach, laws of the game, striking, passing, dribbling and running, receiving, goal keeping, sports injuries awareness assessment, and coaching assessment. The coaching course is 14 hours in duration. Any coach who obtains his/her Junior License will have their fee reimbursed by the Club. Please notify our Club Football Manager, Peter Preston if you are interested.

N.B. ALL COACHES SHOULD HOLD A JUNIOR COACHING LICENSE FOR 'DUTY OF CARE' AND INSURANCE PURPOSES.

CLUB UNIFORMS

Shorts and socks are available to all players from the canteen and on all Registration Days and Allocation Day.

All players must wear the correct uniform, which is available for purchase from the Canteen.

- Black club issued shorts
- Black club issued socks
- Playing shirts are supplied before every game and must be returned to the Coach/Manager at the completion of the game.
- **NO PLAYER IS ALLOWED TO WEAR A CLUB PLAYING SHIRT HOME.**
- **Shins pads must be worn for all games (this is a CCF rule). KDSC strongly suggests the use of shin pads for all training sessions as well.**
- Football boots (no metal studs) or “grass sports” shoes are required.

Alternate strips are available from the canteen if there are team clashes with jerseys. There are a few sizes and if these are used then we would appreciate washing these and returning to the clubhouse before the following week.

SECOND HAND BOOT BOX

The boot box is held at the clubhouse and parents should approach a Committee member if they wish to take advantage of the service. Donations of used boots in reasonable condition are always appreciated.

MATCH DAYS

Association rules require players to be at the ground for their game at least **30 minutes** before kickoff. Please notify your coach as soon as possible if your child will be late, or unable to play, as the coach may be able to organise a replacement.

TRAINING

Notify your coach if your child is unable to attend training. Do not just drop your child at training. Take him/her to the coach and inform the coach if you are not staying or going straight home, in case training is cancelled or you are needed by your child. If you have an appointment, make arrangements with your coach or another parent to be responsible for your child. **THE COACH IS NOT A BABYSITTER FOR YOUR CHILD.**

REPORTING OF INJURIES

All Team Managers are supplied with insurance forms and incident reports at the commencement of the season. Please ensure you get these forms from your manager prior to any hospital or Doctor's visit, as information is required to be completed by a Medical Professional before a claim can be made. In any instance, an incident report should be completed. All forms **MUST** be given to our Club Secretary for Club approval prior to being lodged with the insurance company. Insurance claim forms must reach the insurance company within sixty days of the injury. **LATE CLAIMS MAY NOT BE PAID**. Please refer to the insurance information sheet all players and parents received at the time of registration - this sheet sets out the scope of insurance cover provided by the scheme.

INJURY TREATMENT

If your child receives an injury please follow these instructions:

- R** Rest - please have the child rest the injury as much as possible.
- I** Ice.
- C** Compression - place a compression bandage on the injury if possible.
- E** Elevation - try to raise the injured area to alleviate swelling.

WET WEATHER

In the event of inclement weather, please **DO NOT** phone the Clubhouse or a Committee Member in the first instance. On game days, please contact your team manager, as they are the first people to be notified by a Club Official. You may also refer to our website (www.killarneysoccer.com.au), as this information is updated to reflect any ground closures as timely as possible. The Central Coast Football website is also a great source of information (ccfootball.com.au).

During the week, Wyong Shire Council controls ground status, and as such, the **WET WEATHER HOTLINE** (4350 5491) should be used to check whether training is cancelled.

If the grounds are closed through the week, **DO NOT** under any circumstance train on the fields as any injury sustained will not be covered by insurance, and any fines issued by Council will be passed on to your team.

CENTRAL COAST FOOTBALL POLICY

The CCF's policy for junior competition and non-competition teams which all parents and players should be aware of is: If Saturday games are washed out, may be played on the following Sunday e.g. 8 days later, dependant on how many games need to be made up and is feasible to do so. If the round is again washed out on that Sunday the round will be abandoned. On wet days, if some grounds are open then games scheduled for those grounds will be played. If washed out games from that round are not subsequently played on the following Sunday due to a further bout of wet weather then the CCF Competitions Committee will determine whether the round is abandoned or if the washed out matches will be played at some other time. Competition matches will take precedence over non-competition (U/5-U/9's).

Any washed out or transferred games will be advised to coach and/or manager as soon as practicable after it is receipted. This advice will come via either Fixtures Officer or your respective Football Manager. For any enquiries into possible replays contact Fixtures Officer, but wait a few days after the washout to give time for information to be forwarded. Only coaches or managers are to make these enquiries to respective Committee members.

CLUB POLICY

UNLESS YOU HAVE BEEN TOLD THAT YOUR GAME HAS BEEN CANCELLED, PLAYERS MUST TURN UP, as although it may be raining at Killarney, it could be fine and sunny at Umina. Coaches and Managers do not have the authority to cancel games. If your team does not turn up to the game, the club will be fined by CCF and **THIS FINE WILL BE PASSED ON TO YOUR TEAM. DO NOT RING THE SOCCER CLUB FOR CANCELLATIONS - RING YOUR COACH OR MANAGER OR CHECK OUR WEBSITE <http://www.killarneysoccer.com.au> FOR UP TO DATE INFORMATION.** If players or coaches use the ground when it is closed, future allocation of the grounds to the Club will be placed in jeopardy and the Club will be required to reimburse Council for the cost of repairing any damage caused to the fields.

CANTEEN & MATCH DAY TABLE

The Club operates a canteen at every home game. This is a major fundraiser for the Club and for it to function efficiently parents must carry out their rostered canteen duty. **Teams are only allotted approximately two duties per season, for a period of 3 to 4 hours and this period should be shared by all parents of players in that team.** It is a CCF insurance requirement that no persons under the age of 16 years be permitted in the Canteen.

The official table (match day table) is another area that will benefit with the help of our parents – a Club Official will always be there to guide you, so please don't be afraid to ask!

Your Manager will be informed when your team is rostered on for duty and you should assist by being punctual. Refer to point 6 of the Parents Agreement Form.

Note that **FOOTBALL BOOTS WITH STUDS ARE NOT PERMITTED IN THE CLUBHOUSE.**

NOTICE BOARD

A notice board just inside the clubhouse door displays important information pertaining to Club Gala Days and other upcoming soccer and social events.

GALA DAYS

Our Annual U10 Gala Day is expected to take place in June 2011, where clubs from the Central Coast and Sydney are invited to participate. Please keep checking our website for any news regarding this.

CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS

This competition is run by Football NSW and is a statewide competition at the end of the season. The club nominates each "A" team into this competition to represent the Central Coast. The CCF Board then in turn enters the League Champions of each "A" division to play the winners in each association in NSW. It is an extremely prestigious competition and in past years our Club has enjoyed great success, with a number of teams being crowned State Champions.

The CCF has issued a directive to all football clubs that no alcohol will be permitted at football fields when junior games are being played (including Gala Days).

Wyong Shire Council does not allow smoking or any glass containers on any Council controlled fields. Please ensure that your family and friends adhere to these policies.

The following codes have been adapted from the document "Codes of Behaviour" published by the Australian Sports Commission through the "Aussie Sport" initiative.

PARENT / SPECTATORS CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

1. Remember children are involved in an organised sport for their enjoyment NOT yours.
2. Encourage children to participate if they are interested. However, if a child is not willing, do not force him or her.
3. Focus upon the child's effort and performance rather than the overall result of the game. This reduces the emphasis on winning. Never ridicule or yell at a child for making a mistake or losing a game.
4. REMEMBER: POSITIVE COMMENTS ARE MOTIVATIONAL - NEGATIVE COMMENTS ARE DESTRUCTIVE.
5. Encourage children to always participate according to the rules.
6. Remember that children learn best by example. Applaud good play by all teams.
7. Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from sporting activities.
8. Respect officials' decisions and encourage players to do likewise.
9. Show appreciation of volunteer coaches and officials. Without them players could not participate.
10. Avoid using derogatory language based on gender.
11. By registering your children to play with KDSC you agree to abide by the Parent Agreement Form and to adhere to any direction given by Club officials, CCF officials and officials from other clubs at away matches.
12. Always be conscious of your ambassadorial role. Your actions reflect upon our Club.
13. All CCF venues are strictly no smoking and alcohol free zones during junior games.
14. Photography at CCF events is only permitted for personal use.
15. Professional photographers require club permission before undertaking photography.

If you see any breaches of behaviour please report them to the Club official at the official table at Killarney or at away games. The Club official will be wearing a fluorescent vest.

PLAYERS' CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

1. Play by the rules.
2. **Never argue with an official. If you disagree, have your captain, Coach or Manager approach the official at half time or after the match.**
3. Control your temper - verbal abuse of officials or other players, or deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent is not acceptable or permitted in any sport.
4. Work equally hard for yourself and your team. Your team's performance will benefit and so will you.
5. Be a good sport. Applaud all good players whether they are on your team or the opposition.
6. Treat all players, as you would like to be treated. Do not interfere with or take unfair advantage of another player.
7. Co-operate with your coach, manager, team mates and opponents. Without them there would be no competition.
8. Play for the fun of it and not just to please parents and coaches. Winning adds to the enjoyment of the game but it is not everything.
9. By choosing to play with KDSC you agree to abide by the rules of our Club and must adhere to any direction given by our Club officials, CCF officials and officials from other clubs when you are at away matches.
10. Always be conscious of your ambassadorial role when wearing Club uniform. Your actions always reflect upon our Club.

KILLARNEY DISTRICT SOCCER CLUB PARENT AGREEMENT FORM 2011

Dear Parent/Carer,

You must read and sign this Agreement before your child/children can be registered with Killarney District Soccer Club (KDSC).

If you do not sign this form in the presence of the Club Secretary (or his delegate) your child/children's registration(s) will not be processed.

When you sign this form you are acknowledging your acceptance of the Conditions of Registration listed hereunder.

This form must be then handed to the Registrar who will process the registration of your child/children.

Management Committee

As a condition of registration, I agree to:

1. Abide by the rules of Killarney District Soccer Club (KDSC) as set out in this form
2. Abide by KDSC's Code of Conduct (see Player & Parent Handbook).
3. Abide by the decisions of the Grading Committee. I understand that decisions of the Grading Committee are not negotiable and if I am dissatisfied with any such decision, the Management Committee will not enter into discussion on the matter, but may, upon my written request, arrange for a refund of the Club portion of the registration fee for my child.
4. Ensure that my child/children wear the correct club uniform, which is club black shorts and club black socks. I understand that Club playing shirts must be handed to the Coach/Manager at the completion of each game and that shin pads must be worn at all training sessions and for all games.
5. **PAY MATCH FEES TO THE MANAGER BEFORE EACH GAME. I understand that non-financial players may be stood down until arrears are paid.**
6. **CARRY OUT MATCH DAY TABLE, NET AND CANTEEN DUTIES WHEN ROSTERED.**
7. **Abide by the CCF and Council By-Laws in relation to Alcohol Free/No Smoking zones.**
8. Permission is given to photograph and print said photos of players in Clubs' promotional material.
9. Notify the Coach/Manager personally and with reasonable notice, if my child/children are unable to attend training or games.
10. Purchasing of club clothing or merchandise outside of the club needs to be sanctioned to ensure it complies with our corporate/club identity.
11. Any public representation of the club such as chat rooms/forums or other electronic means needs to comply with the club policies & identity.
12. Supervise my child/children on match days and at training. I understand the importance of this condition, particularly when the weather is inclement and matches/training may be cancelled at short notice, or when my child/children misbehave either at training or on match days.
13. Accept the right of the Coach, Manager or other interested persons to bring to the notice of the Club's Management Committee or CCF Appeals Board any misbehavior at training or on match day. Any such misbehavior may be referred to the Club's Internal Judiciary or the CCF Appeals Board for assessment, hearing and decision.

14. Any person summonsed to appear before the Club's Internal Judiciary or CCF Appeals Board who neglects to appear without prior or satisfactory explanation to the Club President/Secretary or CCF Chairman/Secretary of the Appeals Board shall be dealt with in terms of suspension, bond, fine reprimand or a combination thereof as the Club Management Committee or CCF Appeals Board sees fit.
15. Any player who does not appear before the Club's Internal Judiciary or CCF Appeals Board when ordered may be suspended by the Club's Management Committee or CCF Appeals Board until such time as the player appears before it.
16. Abide by any reasonable decisions made by the Club's Internal Judiciary and/or Club Management and/or CCF Appeals Board.
17. Supervise my child/children on Presentation Day, and accept responsibility for my child/ren's actions.
18. **Acknowledge receipt of the soccer ball/s (no.) AND/OR club shorts and accept responsibility for same. I understand that this ball/s is/are required at every training session during 2011.**
19. **I have read, understand, accept and acknowledge receipt of the FFA conditions.**
20. **I have received the Accident Support brochure and declare that the player(s) named under 'Children's Details' is/are a full time student.**
